	Hebrews 11:8-9 : By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise.

	Hebrews 11:10 : For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God.
	Romans 4:13: It was not through the law that Abraham and his offspring received the promise that he would be heir of the world, but through the righteousness that comes by faith.

	Hebrews 11:11-12 : And by faith even Sarah, who was past childbearing age, was enabled to bear children because she considered him faithful who had made the promise. And so from this one man, and he as good as dead, came descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sand on the seashore.
	Genesis 21:1-5: Now the LORD was gracious to Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did for Sarah what he had promised. Sarah became pregnant and bore a son to Abraham in his old age, at the very time God had promised him. Abraham gave the name Isaac to the son Sarah bore him.

Matthew 19:26: Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

When his son Isaac was eight days old, Abraham circumcised him, as God commanded him.

John 3:3, 5-7: Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again."...Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.'
